I. INTRODUCTION

The 15th Bali Democracy Forum (BDF) of 2022 will address the theme of “Democracy in a Changing World: Leadership and Solidarity”.

The current state of democracy globally is perceived as either declining, stagnating, or even retreating. The rise of elected authoritarians and the re-emergence of populism are arguably challenging the norms and functioning of democracy. There is also a growing perception that in dealing with various crises – the COVID-19 pandemic, food insecurity, energy crises, and other public goods scarcity – democracy is seen as not better than its alternatives.

Democracy should be nurtured from its social roots and rejuvenated through people’s legitimacy and governance practices. Thus the forum aims to reflect, share, and rethink possible responses to the abovementioned conundrums. Instead of questioning and disenfranchising democracy, the forum will explore the possibility of more and deepening democracy.

In this connection, the 15th BDF will discuss two main issues, namely:

1. Fair and Equitable Access of Global Public Goods: Democratic Responses.
2. Democracy at the Crossroad: Shaping Governance in the New Global Landscape.

The forum’s main objective is to provide a platform for sharing experiences among state actors and invited stakeholders to share knowledge, insights, and understanding of the democratic values of leadership and solidarity in a changing world. At the same time, it aims to share experiences and lessons learned on enabling democracy, secure fair and equitable access to global public goods and shape governance in the new global landscape.

Prior to the 15th BDF, as an attempt to discuss this year’s theme, the Committee also organized the Road to BDF event, Bali Civil Society and Media Forum (will be held on 6-7 December 2022).

With the adjustment due to the pandemic, the 15th BDF will be convened on a hybrid format and attended on-site and virtual by participants, including Government officials and diplomatic leaderships, CSOs, academicians, researchers, journalists, and public figures.

The forum will consist of the Opening Session, Panel Discussions, Press Briefing from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia, and Closing Session.

3. Fill in media registration form and attach the following documents:
 - a. Letter of assignment from the editor/executive of the media;
 - b. A form of identification — KTP for locals or passports for non-Indonesian citizens.
4. Upon successful media accreditation, a confirmation letter will be sent to confirm your accreditation.
5. **Foreign Journalists/Media not based in Indonesia** can only cover the event virtually by registering as stated in the Registration Process Point 3.
6. Opening and closing session of the 15th BDF can be accessed through Youtube MoFA Kemlu RI (<https://www.youtube.com/c/MoFAIndonesia>). The committee will also provide the documentation (videos and pictures) and any important information to support the media coverage.

c. Collection for ID Badges

7. Media ID badges can be collected at the **Mengwi 1, BNDCC 2 from 6 to 7 Desember 2022, from 9 AM to 6 PM** Central Indonesia Time (UTC+8) by showing their photo ID, passport, or diplomatic identity card, and signing the receipt form at the registration counter.

- Opening hours for the media centre are from 09.00 AM to 06.00 PM.

- The media centre will also provide adequate working space.
- News releases, selected documentation; including statements, speeches and/or announcements will also be available at the media centre.

The Media Secretariat at the Media Centre will arrange a Press Conference on a case-by-case basis. We will provide a link for the media to cover the Press Conference and the events.

VI. HEALTH PROTOCOL

Pre-Arrival

- a. Media representatives must comply with rules and regulations from the Government of Indonesia. Every media representative **must have a minimum of two doses of vaccination certificate dated 14 days prior to their departure.**
- b. The general travel requirements to be allowed to enter the territory of Indonesia includes the use of PeduliLindungi app. Please download and install and complete the user profile in the app. PeduliLindungi is an application developed by the Indonesian government to monitor Covid-19 cases. This application can be downloaded through this [link](#). PeduliLindungi must be used throughout your stay in Indonesia.
- c. Suppose there are updates regarding regulation on COVID-19 health protocol for all participants, the BDF Committee will immediately notify all in writing.

Arrival

- d. Upon arrival at the entry points, journalists must undergo a COVID-19 symptom check, including a body temperature check, with the following conditions:
 - If there is no symptom and body temperature is below 37.5 degrees Celsius, RT-PCR upon arrival is not necessary.
 - If a symptom and body temperature is above 37.5 degrees Celsius, journalists must undergo an RT-PCR examination upon arrival.
- e. All journalists are expected to comply with the existing laws and regulations pertaining to COVID-19 health protocols in force in Indonesia.

- f. All journalists are required to take the rapid test antigen on 7 December 2022 provided by BDF Committee as a requirement for direct coverage.
